Recent honors include being chosen as alumnus of the year at the U of C in 2002, International Bone and Joint Decade “Builder” in 2005, top 40 alumni at U of C in 2006, awarded a University Research Professorship in 2007, and in March 2011 he and his ABJHI colleagues received a Canadian Institutes of Health Research/Canadian Medical Association Journal Top Achievements in Health Research for 2010 Award for their work on “Improving access to hip and knee replacement and its quality by adopting a new model of care in Alberta”.
