Dr. Dulai is a Paediatric Orthopaedic Surgeon at the Stollery Children's Hospital and Glenrose Rehabilitation Hospital (Edmonton, AB). She is a Professor in the Department of Surgery at the University of Alberta. She is a founding member and past president of the Canadian Paediatric Orthopaedic Group (CPOG, now CPOS), the current Second President Elect of the Canadian Orthopaedic Association and a former ABC fellow (2019).

Her clinical subspecialty interests are limb deformities, hip dysplasia and neuromuscular disorders. She is the co-chair of the Paediatric Orthopaedic and Rehabilitation medicine Research Team of Alberta (PORRTAL) and the orthopaedic lead of the Paediatric Developmental Hip Dysplasia study group at the University of Alberta.
