Dr. Kreder is a Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery and Health Policy Evaluation and Management at the University of Toronto. He has a subspecialty practice at Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre in pelvic and acetabular trauma and lower extremity reconstruction.

Dr. Kreder's main research interests involve the measurement of function and other outcomes following traumatic musculoskeletal injuries, arthritic conditions and metastatic disease, as well as policy issues regarding access to care and the effect of provider experience and volume on patient outcome. He was the first recipient of the AAOS / OREF Health Services Fellowship Award in 1993 and he was the inaugural Marvin Tile Chair at Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre in 2006. He is an Adjunct Scientist at the Institute for Clinical and Evaluative Sciences and a faculty member of AO trauma. He is a former AO Trustee representing Canada.
